

Business owners provide healthcare services to those who choose to live or work in the UAE, and these services, like all other infrastructure and amenities, are of the highest quality. The UAE healthcare system provides cutting-edge medical technology and highly qualified medical professionals, making it an exceptional healthcare ecosystem.

Obtaining medical insurance in the UAE is also simple and inexpensive, with the average medical plan costing around AED 10,000 (USD 2700) per year. In Dubai, family health insurance coverage for basic medical services ranges from AED 17000 to 18000 (approximately USD 4900). Expats' annual premiums for comprehensive health insurance can be around AED 5,500. There are numerous options available for coverage, whether for yourself, your family, or through your employer.


Part IV

In recent months, as the UAE's tourism, construction, and Expo 2020-related activities increased, the country's outlook became more positive and optimistic. According to the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the UAE's economy is projected to grow by over 6 percent this year, which is significant. This is because the country's growth rate was only 3.8 percent in 2021, and reaching the 6 percent mark would match the record growth rate of 6.9 percent achieved in 2011, making it the highest growth rate ever recorded.

With the combination of higher oil prices and successful COVID-19 mitigation measures, the UAE's economy grew by 8.4 percent in the first quarter of this year, exceeding initial predictions and setting the tone for the rest of the year's growth. All these figures are indicative of a brighter future for the emirate.


